Kabul City May 30th, 2010.

The Special Investigation Commission on Leadership or Membership of Illegal Armed Groups, chaired by the IEC in terms of Article 12(7) of the Electoral Law, has reported 85 names of persons who are listed in the preliminary list of parliamentary candidates as being members of illegal armed groups.

Upon receipt of this report the ECC has asked the Special Investigation Commission to review these cases and has allowed the candidates concerned until 14th of Jawza (4 June 2010) to persuade the said Commission that they are not members of armed groups.

According to the above-mentioned Article of the Electoral Law, candidates who are members of illegal armed groups are deprived of the right of nomination and will be removed from the candidates' list by the ECC.
