The Electoral Complaints Commission (ECC) has received complaints about certain candidates for the Wolesi Jirga who did not resign in time from their official positions but continued to occupy them.

These complaints are still under scrutiny by the ECC. However, if the allegations are true, these candidates would have violated article 13 of the Electoral Law. Hence, these candidates should be deprived of their candidacy in terms of article 63(1) of the Law.

The ECC calls on all Afghans to inform the ECC head office or any Provincial Electoral Complaints Commissions (PECC) if they have information about the commission of such electoral offences so that the necessary legal steps can be taken.
